

# Bulletin

## Consolidated Technology Guide

This Bulletin is issued in accordance with the section of the Consolidated Technology Guide (the “**Guide**”) entitled *Notification of Changes and Updates*. The purpose of this Bulletin is to notify Licensees that a new version of the Guide has been published that supersedes and replaces the prior version of the Guide. This version of the Guide contains updates to the Software Subscription Agreement terms and conditions.

In addition to minor clerical and clean-up edits, including typo corrections, renumbering of sections, reformatting and other similar modifications, the updated Guide includes the following substantive changes:

| 2.—Definitions  | Definitions added for “Fannie Mae Data” and “Fannie Mae Output”. The definition of “Fannie Mae Data” is excerpted language from Section 5.10 that is based on Selling Guide Section A2-4.1-02, and “Fannie Mae Output” specifically refers to output generated by a Fannie Mae application.  |
| 3.—Grant of Rights and Imposition of Restrictions and Obligations | Section entitled “Restrictions on Use” now includes supplemental language that clarifies restrictions related to the disclosure and use of Fannie Mae Data by third parties. Specifically, licensees may only disclose or permit the use of Fannie Mae Data for purposes related to the Licensee’s mortgage-related business purposes or in connection with loans eligible for sale to Fannie Mae or for the support of any technology integration or interface. |
| 5.10.—Rights in Data  | Section revised to improve clarity concerning rights and obligations with respect to Fannie Mae Data.  |

All changes described above are effective as of the Effective Date indicated in this Bulletin in accordance with the Section of the General Terms and Conditions entitled “Issued Bulletins; Amendments.” All other terms and conditions of the Software Subscription Agreement shall continue in full force and effect. If there is any inconsistency between or among the provisions contained in the Guide and this Bulletin, the provisions of the Guide will govern.
